

Heldenplatz serves as the main Museum Information Point for all visitors of the "ORF Long Night of Museums". Information, booklets and tickets will be available at Heldenplatz at the following times:

> Thursday, October 4th, 2 pm-6 pm, October 5th, 10 am-6 pm, Friday. Saturday, October 6th, from 9 am.

TICKFTS

The ticket will be valid on October 6th, 2012 from 6 pm to 1 am as an **admission** ticket for all locations and events listed in this booklet, and also as a ticket for public transport services in Vienna.

Ticket prices are € 13.- (regular ticket)

€ 11.- (reduced price)

Tickets at reduced price are available for Ö1-Club members, school children, students, senior citizens, disabled persons and for males in their obligatory term of military or civilian service.

Free admission for children age 12 and under, born after October 5th, 2000.

Tickets are available in advance at tickets.ORF.at, at the Museum Information Point at the times listed above, and at the museums participating in this programme. On the night itself they can be purchased at the Museum Information Point or at any museum.

TRANSPORT SERVICES

The ticket is valid for the "Long Night" shuttle buses and from October 6th, 2012 4 pm to October 7th, 2012 3 am, it is also valid for **public transport services in** Vienna, including the Nightline buses. Children age 12 and under are allowed to use public transport if accompanied by an adult with a "Long Night" ticket.

The routes of the shuttle buses are connected to the underground lines, making individual tours possible.

RUSTINES

Locations in the Inner City of Vienna are within walking distance ("city walk"). Most locations outside the Inner City will be connected by shuttle buses or can be reached by underground.

Bus lines 1 to 5 will start from the Museum Information Point at Heldenplatz and offer a hop-on-hop-off bus service in intervals of about 15 minutes. Lines A to F will connect underground stations to locations in Vienna's outer districts. Please find the exact routes in this booklet or on the internet.

All stops are specially marked and equipped with a map of the area and directions to the museums.

Additionally, a special oldtimer shuttle service will operate between Heldenplatz and MuseumsQuartier Wien.

EVENTS AND STARTING TIMES

Please find the starting times of events in this booklet. If not stated otherwise, programmes (especially guided tours) will be offered in German only.







The Third Man chase scene with Orson Welles as Harry Lime through the Vienna sewers is one of the most famous in the history of film. Today, these very same sewers of Vienna's waste water enterprise are among Europe's most modern sewage systems.



Endoscopy is a diagnostic method to examine the interior of a hollow organ or cavity of the body by means of inspecting it with endoscopes. These medical devices can consist of either a rigid tube with an illumination system and an optical system or, if it is the flexible endoscope (fibre endoscope), of bundles of fibre optics. The endoscopes serve the diagnosis and make biopsies and surgical procedures at sight possible. Endoscopy can applied in the urinary tract (cystoscopy), the stomach (gastroscopy). intestine or colon (rectoscopy, colonoscopy), the respiratory tract (bronchoscopy), the abdominal cavity (laparoscopy), the organs of the chest (thoracoscopy) or the interior of a joint (arthroscopy). The development and use of endoscopy from its beginnings to the present are documented in the world's largest collection of endoscopes in the Nitze-Leiter Research Society, primarily original devices (endoscopes and equpiment) and images are on display.



The Haus-, Hof and Staatsarchiv was founded by Maria Theresia on Sept. 13th, 1749 and, in the course of its history, has grown into one of the great institutions of historical research known worldwide. Here Carolingian diplomas can be found as well as essential treaties of the organisation of Europe - for example the Peace of Westphalia or the Final Document of the Congress of Vienna. which has been included in the "Memory of the World" register by the UNESCO - the first print of Luther's Theses, family correspondences of the Habsburgs and reports of imperial diplomats from all over Europe and overseas. Apart from the material about the history of the Habsburg Empire, original historical documents from Germany, Italy and the Ottoman Empire represent the biggest part. In its beginnings, the archive was situated in the Reichskanzlei wing of the New Imperial Palace and several repositories outside. In 1902, all holdings were united in a functional building at Minoritenplatz, the repository wing of which constitutes a first-rate technical monument.



On Gallitzinberg in Ottakring, Vienna, there is an observatory dating from the time of historism. It once belonged to a tycoon in the Austro-Hungarian monarchy and has retained its historical appearance up to the present. 

Already in the Middle Ages life at the markets in Vienna was quite a busy one. Even today, names of streets and places in the first district still commemorate those former market places: Hoher Markt. Fleischmarkt, Bauernmarkt, etc. Quite frequently the organisation and regulations of those old market places are mentioned. The question is who is responsible for the compliance with these regulations? Since the year 1839, it has been the Market Office of the Municipality of Vienna.

The Museum of the Market Office of the Municipality of Vienna, which was re-opened only in 2012, gives an insight into its long existence. Pictures of market places in the past and the present are on display. Old measures are explained, visitors can try to lift a centner. Scales that are 130 years old or even older can be tried out and/or inspected. Food controls then and now are being documented with the help of picture material and the tools used. Different models, which partly date from the 19th century, like wax models with potato diseases as well as coffee beans made from dough, are also shown.

Motorrolldie is a place of memories of a time in which we, our parents, grandparents, friends or acquaintances owned motorcycles like the ones exhibited. The museum was founded by vintage motorcycle collectors in 2006. The collection shows a cross-section of motor scooters and motorcycles, which until recently were still used in everyday road traffic. The motorcycles on display are from 1932 to 1978, the range of brands covers Puch, HMW, Lohner, Adler, Vespa, Standard, Zündapp and others. Many of the vehicles are licensed and are still regularly used. Moreover, old radios and tape recorders as well as old children's toys and different objects connected to motorcycles and cars from the 50s to the 70s can be seen in the collection.

MUSA is the name of the contemporary art collection of the Department for Cultural Affairs of the City of Vienna. This institution comprises the presentation space for thematic exhibitions compiled from works in the collection (the museum), the Start Gallery for young Viennese artists and the Artothek, which loans graphic art for private use.

The Museum of Aspern-Essling offers an overview of the military conflict between the French and Austrian troops in May 1809. I exhibits a documentation of the circumstances, displaying different sorts of weapons, uniforms, bullets and several pictures of the military leaders. In 1858, Archduke Albrecht, son of Archduke Karl, had a monument erected in order to remind people of the victims of that war. This monument, the Lion of Aspern, was built by the artist Anton Fernkorn. The lion is portraved lying on French warflags. The French Eagle and the flags are the symbols of the French cavalry. The animal's head is positioned on a French helmet. The lion symbolises the brave soldiers who fought, won and died. The victory of the German soldiers over the French army is represented by the oak leaves around the pedestal. In the face of the dying lion you can read melancholy and anger, strength and steeliness in its posture. Pressing his nails into the stone, the animal is dving.

The oil painting "The Battle of Aspern" by Clara Both will also be on display. It is a present given by Dr. Hans von Wimpffen for the 200-year anniversary.

Under "natural" circumstances, a woman has approximately 15 pregnancies in her lifetime, resulting in ten births, depending on health, sanitation, housing conditions, access to clean water and proper nutrition etc. Approximately seven of those ten births survive childhood. For economic, social or other reasons, most people neither presently nor historically want so many children. For all generations and in most cultures, regulating the number of offspring has been and remains an essential issue. To do so. contraception, abortion and infanticide have been practiced. Most women/couples have had and still have little or no access to effective contraception or safe abortion - conducted under "State of the Art" conditions. This is only possible if abortion is legalized, otherwise it will (again) be performed on hidden kitchen tables. The first and only museum of its kind (First awardee of the Kenneth Hudson Award from Trustees of the European Museum Forum) displays the struggle for control over fertility – from early centuries to the present with a glance into the future. The museum aims to provide a greater understanding of the power of fertility and the necessity of regulating it.





The Papyrus Collection with its 180,000 objects is one of the largest in the world. In October 2001 the collection was included in UNESCO's list "Memory of the World" as a world documentation heritage site. The Papyrus Museum, with about 200 objects on display, illustrates the life of people living in the Nile Valley over a period of three thousand years. The objects on display range from the oldest papyrus in the collection, a Book of the Dead from the middle of the second millennium BC, to documents of the Islamic period written on paper in the 13th century AD.

The Vienna Police Museum emerged from the exhibits of a police showcase in 1898 due to the 50th jubilee of emperor Francis Joseph's ascension to the throne. Initially housed in the (old) Police Department on Schottenring it was relocated in 1904 into the prestigious premises of the newly constructed office building on Elisabeth promenade (now Roßauer Lände), then was transfered again in 1938 and in the course of the war it was almost completely destroyed.

In the 1970s, the remaining old stock was contemporary updated and got rearranged in a 200-sqm-large hall of the Marokkaner Casern. The presentation shows the development of the Vienna Police – Security Guard Department since their establishment in 1869 by means of weapons, uniforms, documents, pictures and diagrams.

The progress was intimately related to the history of the Marokkaner Casern (founded in 1770), which, since the takeover by the Police in 1921, has also been housing the educational department.



The Baroque State Hall is one of the world's most beautiful historic libraries. Emperor Charles VI ordered the construction of this jewel of secular Baroque architecture for his Court Library. The State Hall was built from 1723 till 1726 according to the plans of the famous court architect Johann Bernhard Fischer von Erlach, and carried out by his son Joseph Emanuel. The ceiling frescoes were completed in 1730 by the court painter Daniel Gran. Today the State Hall is home to 200 books from 1501 till 1850, among them the 15,000 volumes of Prince Eugene of Savoy's (1663–1736) collection in the middle oval.

In the Museum of Chimney Sweepers, visitors will find permanent and changing exhibitions on a space totalling 250 square metres. A cellar, where antique kilns and water heaters are on display, completes the museum. At the entrance, a life-like model in the original heavy leather gear of chimney sweepers will greet and welcome visitors into the "living museum", which has been set up in the form of a chimney sweeper's workshop as they were still in use until the 1950s. Next to it, there is a slate blackboard, which was placed outside each sweeper's office, for customers to post their orders. Atop a cupboard, a wooden statue of Saint Florian, patron saint of the chimney sweepers, can be seen. The exhibition is rounded off by important tools of the sweeper's trade.

SPECIAL EXHIBITION: AMERICAN INDIANS - FACT AND FICTION

Smoke signals from the Museum of Chimney Sweepers.

On the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the film adaptation of "Winnetou", memorabilia from the films, admission tickets, leaflets and brochures are shown. 





The building of the Postal Savings Bank, which was built from 1904 to 1912, is considered the main work of Art Nouveau architect Otto Wagner. Countless details such as the world's largest cast aluminium sculptures measuring 4.5 metres on the roof of the building's main facade, innovative materials, like aluminium, glass and linoleum, and above all, a completely new style of architecture based on functionality make Otto Wagner's building of the Postal Savings Bank a key example of modern architecture. With this late work, Wagner has become one of the internationally most influential architects of the 20th century.

Additionally to the permanent exhibition in and around the "Small Banking Hall", the WAGNER: WERK Museum also designs and organises temporary special exhibitions in the "Large Banking Hall", which deal with the architecture and design history of the 20th century.

The "New Vienna" of the 1920s and early 1930s is a unique sociopolitical experiment, as it embraces all spheres of life - from social and health policy to education and housing issues. The permanent exhibition "Red Vienna at the Wash House Karl-Marx-Hof" is dedicated to this exciting era in the history of our city. The exhibition covers four fields:

- "Red Vienna's" history (1919-1934)
- "Red Vienna's" communal housing and ancillary facilities
- Clubs of the Social Democratic Workers' Party
- The festivities of Vienna's working-class movement

The permanent exhibition is located at Wash House No. 2, which is still used as a laundry on the ground floor, just as it was at the opening of Karl-Marx-Hof in 1930. On the first floor, where originally the bathtubs and showers were accommodated, visitors can find out all about the "Red Vienna".



The Fire Department Museum, founded in 1901, has had a long tradition in Vienna. It is situated in the "Märkleinsche Haus". which was designed by Lukas von Hildebrandt and built in the years 1727 to 1730. The exhibition rooms on the first floor include a large hall with an impressive stuccoed ceiling in which parts of the paintings collection are shown.



THE FIRE BRIGADE IN THE SECOND WORLD WAR

The special exhibition provides an overview over the Vienna fire brigade in World War II, known then as fire protection police ("Feuerschutzpolizei"). The focus lies on resistance fighters among the firemen and on the adverse conditions, especially towards the end of the war, under which they tried to sustain an effective fire protection.

PRESENTATIONS, EVERY 45 MINUTES

During the "ORF Long Night of Museums", presentations on special topics such as the special exhibition, the fire in the Ringtheater or the fire in the rotunda will be held in 45-minute intervals.

The museum possesses an extensive collection of historical shoes from different centuries. You can see not only the riding boots of Emperor Francis Joseph, but also soccer boots from the 1930s, the time of Viennese soccer legend Matthias Sindelar. The shoes from Empress Elisabeth's time are good examples of exclusive shoe design of the second half of the 19th century. A workshop allows a nostalgic view into the past. The museum provides information on technical workflows, materials, traditional techniques and the history of the development of shoes.

Since November 2005, the Vienna State Opera has had its own museum, where the history of the house on the Vienna Ringstraße since its opening in the year 1968 is being documented. Upon entering the museum, you will be guided into the world of opera by portraits of current and former singers. In the museum, you will be taken on a journey through time from the past of the opera house to the most important performances of the present.

Stage designs, historical costumes and singers' portraits will tell you about the glorious history of the house. Photographs and play bills commemorate legendary opera nights and important events such as debut performances or first nights. Scores and correspondences provide an insight into what is going on behind the scenes. Models of stage designs and costumes illustrate the making of a production.

Special attention is given to Gustav Mahler, who was head of the Vienna Court Opera from 1897 to 1907 and who has decisively influenced the artistic profile of the house to this day.

At three terminals, you can access the cast of all performances since November 1955.




